**Artist and Craft Vendors:** An Artist and/or Arts and Craft Vendor is defined as offering items which have been individually handmade or designed by the artist or crafter represented, this includes pre-packaged homemade food products, such as jams or salsa. All merchandise offered for sale must be handcrafted items that have been sculpted, painted, photographed, designed, constructed, or otherwise fashioned by the artist or artisan. No electricity will be supplied to Arts and Craft Vendors. No ready to eat or drink food or water products can be sold or offered for free by Arts and Craft vendors. (samples of prepacked food items are OK)

**Food Vendor:** A food vendor is defined as any business, person/ persons whose primary purpose at the festival is selling food or drinks for consumption on site. We aim for diversity in the food being sold and we will not accept multiple vendors selling similar offerings. We offer 15 Food Vendor spaces that are supplied with electricity. There will be an extra \$20-dollar charge for use of electricity. If a Vendor desired to utilize their own generator, it will need to be approved prior to vendor acceptance. We do request that you utilize some type of sound barrier for your generator.

Each Food Vendor must provide insurance with the festival as an additional insured and a Food Service Permit from the County Board of Health. Inspections are prior to the beginning of the festival. The documents can be downloaded with your application to the CASA Mountain Arts Festival.

**Application and Photo Requirements:**

Each vendor who applies will need to submit an application with 3-5 pictures of their merchandise or booth setup (no bigger than a total of 5 megabytes). Photos may be featured on our accounts including Facebook, Instagram, Newspaper, printed materials, etc. for promotional purposes. By submitting the photos, you acknowledge that we can use them at our discretion for this event. This is a juried event.

The CASA planning committee will review each application. We want to offer a diverse offering to the public and will not place all similar vendors together. We want you to have a successful show and profit. We reserve the right to approve and deny applications to ensure that the quality of vendors meet the criteria of our event.

**Application deadline is Aug 15, 2021. All booth fees must be received no later than Aug 20, 2021**

Applications will be selected on a “first come, first paid” basis.

- Arts Vendor Rate \$150 After July 1, 2021
- Food Vendor \$250 – After July 1, 2021
- Early Bird & Returning Art Vendors Rate \$125
- Early Bird & Returning Food Vendors \$200
- Vendor Booth fees are due before the booth space is assigned.
- Onsite Camping Fee \$45

**Other Information:**

There will be no sharing of spaces or trading of spaces.

Every Vendor is required to bring their own tables, chairs, credit card machines etc. All booths are outdoors, so it is suggested you bring a tent to cover your space. Please make sure it does not overlap into anyone else’s space. Each Arts and Crafts booth space is 10X10 and will be clearly numbered and marked.

WIFI will be available. Plan ahead when deciding what credit card machine to use or payment methods to take. Vendor setup begins on Friday, Sept. 10 at 5pm and continues until 9:30am Saturday morning. All vehicles must be clear of the pedestrian walkway by 9:30am Saturday, September 11<sup>th</sup>. More details about the vendor check-in and booth assignment upon the acceptance of each vendor. Onsite camping is available for an additional fee of \$45. This fee guarantees a spot for tent/car camping with access to portable toilets. (No running water available)
